The Pledge of Allegiance followed the invocation.

Motion by Wishart, supported by Campbell, to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting and to accept them as presented.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Mankowski, supported by Campbell, to amend the agenda for the meeting by adding the following under New Business: Giving Full-Time Employees a Voucher for a Ham or Turkey for the holiday season.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Campbell, supported by Sharrard, to accept the second reading of an amendment to the City of Gaylord Ordinance Code, FIREWORKS ORDINANCE. This Ordinance will regulate the ignition, discharge and use of certain fireworks in the City.

Ordinance becomes effective December 16, 2012.

Motion by Campbell, supported by Wishart, to repeal 20.278, Section 4103.38, FIREWORKS, PROHIBITIONS; PERMIT of the City of Gaylord Ordinance Code.

Nays: Mankowski. Motion carried.

Motion by Mankowski, supported by Johnson, to give all full-time employees a \$30 voucher for a ham or turkey for the holiday season.
