The Pledge of Allegiance followed the invocation.

Members Present: Campbell, Duczkowski, Jenkins, Johnson, Sharrard and Wishart.

Members Absent: Mankowski.

Motion by Duczkowski, supported by Campbell, to amend the agenda for the meeting by adding under New Business, the following: Consideration of Permits for Advertising on a Temporary Basis.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Campbell, supported by Wishart, to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting and to accept them as presented.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Johnson, supported by Sharrard, to excuse the absence of Council Member Mankowski.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Sharrard, supported by Campbell, to enter into an agreement with the Board of Otsego County Road Commissioners to provide for the engineering design and construction of the Mankowski Road Extension Project, to stipulate the duties and responsibilities of the City of Gaylord regarding such and to authorize access to Crossing Earmark and MDOT safety grant funds, received by the Otsego County Road Commission, to assist in financing the project.

Motion by Campbell, supported by Duczkowski, to proclaim the month of April 2013 as "Social Host Awareness Month".

Mr. Tony Kesselring of International RV World, 277 Expressway Court, Livingston Township, appeared before City Council to request permission to place temporary promotional advertising banners at 1260 West Main Street, in the City of Gaylord.
